DIG REGULATIONS

- A. DPW is the approving authority for all excavations within the cantonment area. Excavation requests (CMTC form 200) will be submitted to Facilities Operations Specialist once complete, who can be reached at 662-294-0290.
- B. Units will submit excavation requests (CMTC form 200) to capture dig approval for each training event no later than 14 days prior to start date.
- C. Excavation requests are required for all military digging, mechanical or by hand, and for training activities that change the landscape of the training lands (for examples: foxholes, battle positions, bunkers, fuel sites, berms, obstacle belts, mobile kitchen trailer (MKT) soakage pits, tent stakes, generator rod placement etc.).
- D. Site recovery. Unit training is not over until all excavation sites are properly recovered. Units are responsible for properly marking all unfilled sites, especially during darkness, until the sites are refilled. Units are subject to spot inspections by DPW, or Environmental. Inspectors will be looking for approved dig requests and current overlays at unit's sites. Approved request and overlay must be at the site prior, during excavation, and at the site until the site is recovered.

- I understand that the proposed digging or excavation is a requirement within the scope of work to be accomplished. I will not dig or excavate before receiving written approval from the Directorate of Public Works (DPW). I understand my responsibilities and obligations pursuant to safety, property damage, personal injury, and life-threatening hazards associated with digging in the vicinity of underground utilities (including utilities such as electrical cables and pipes containing natural gas, water, sewer, liquefied fuels, and refrigerants). Severe injuries, death, and extensive property damage may occur as a result of digging through underground utilities. I am responsible for damages caused to persons or property as a result of my fault or negligence. If the exact locations of underground utilities are unknown, I will perform whatever work is necessary to determine exact locations and avoid damaging utilities.
- Unless otherwise permitted, I will not excavate within 50 meters of streams, natural drains, roads, and tank trails. I will not dig or deposit excavated spoil within 10 meters of trees.
- If archaeological resources, UXOs, etc are discovered during excavation, I or my representative will notify DPW, at 662-294-0290, and suspend disturbance of the finding until DPW issues guidance.
- Upon completion, I will restore the excavation site including backfilling, and reshaping to conform to surrounding topography.
