Personnel: Not applicable.


Authority: Message, 320069, Department of the Army, 19 October 1962.

Authority is granted to retain in the federal service rear detachments consisting of not more than four individuals per troop-size unit, plus five individuals per squadron and higher headquarters, for not more than 5 days. Rear detachments may be utilized in the Oxford, Mississippi, area or at home station or a combination of both.
